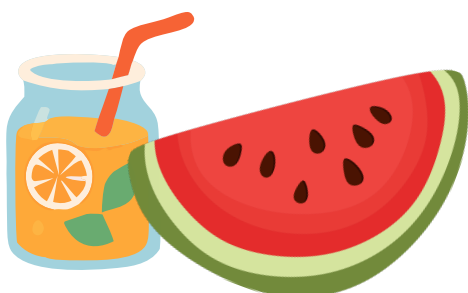

out of love.

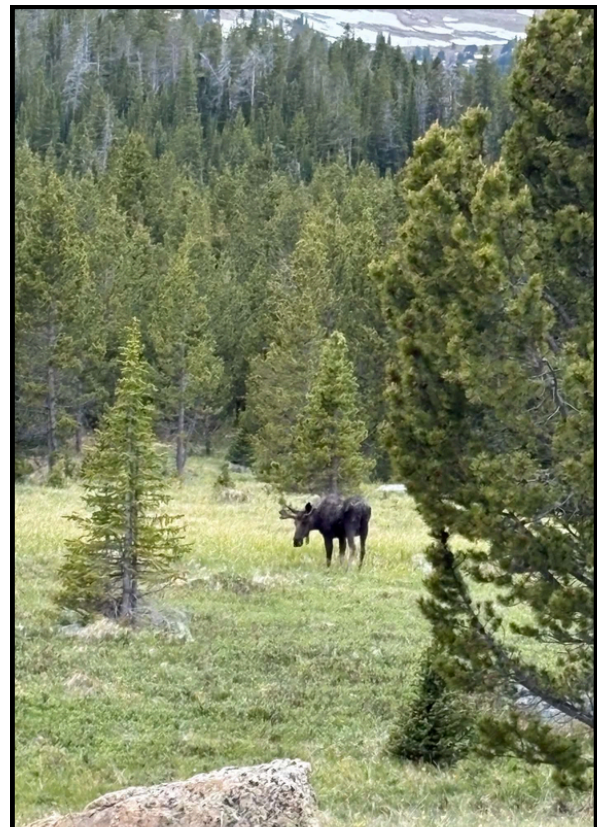
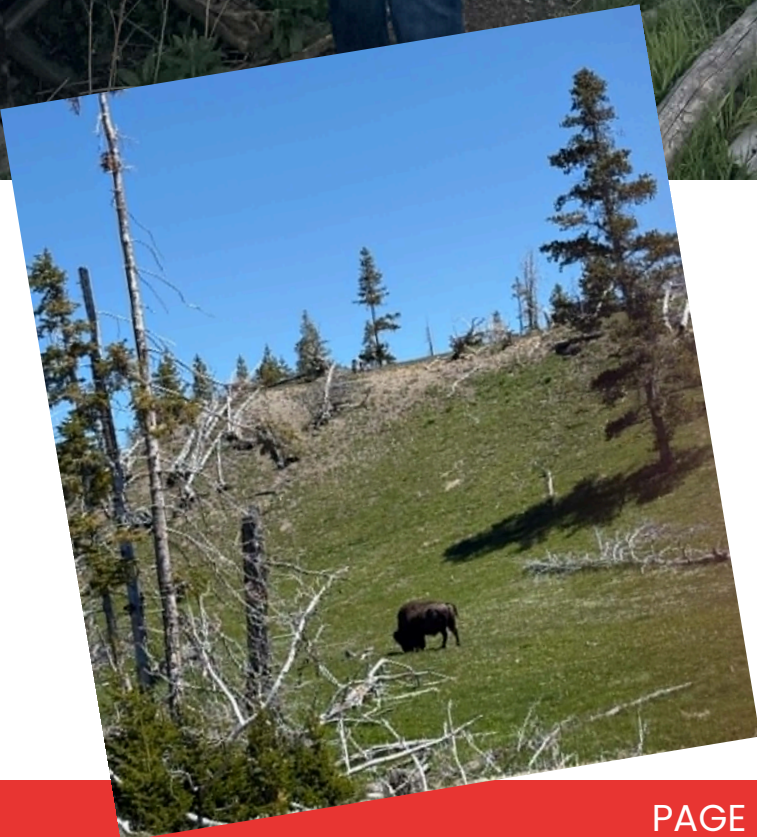
We ask that you protect them, surround them
